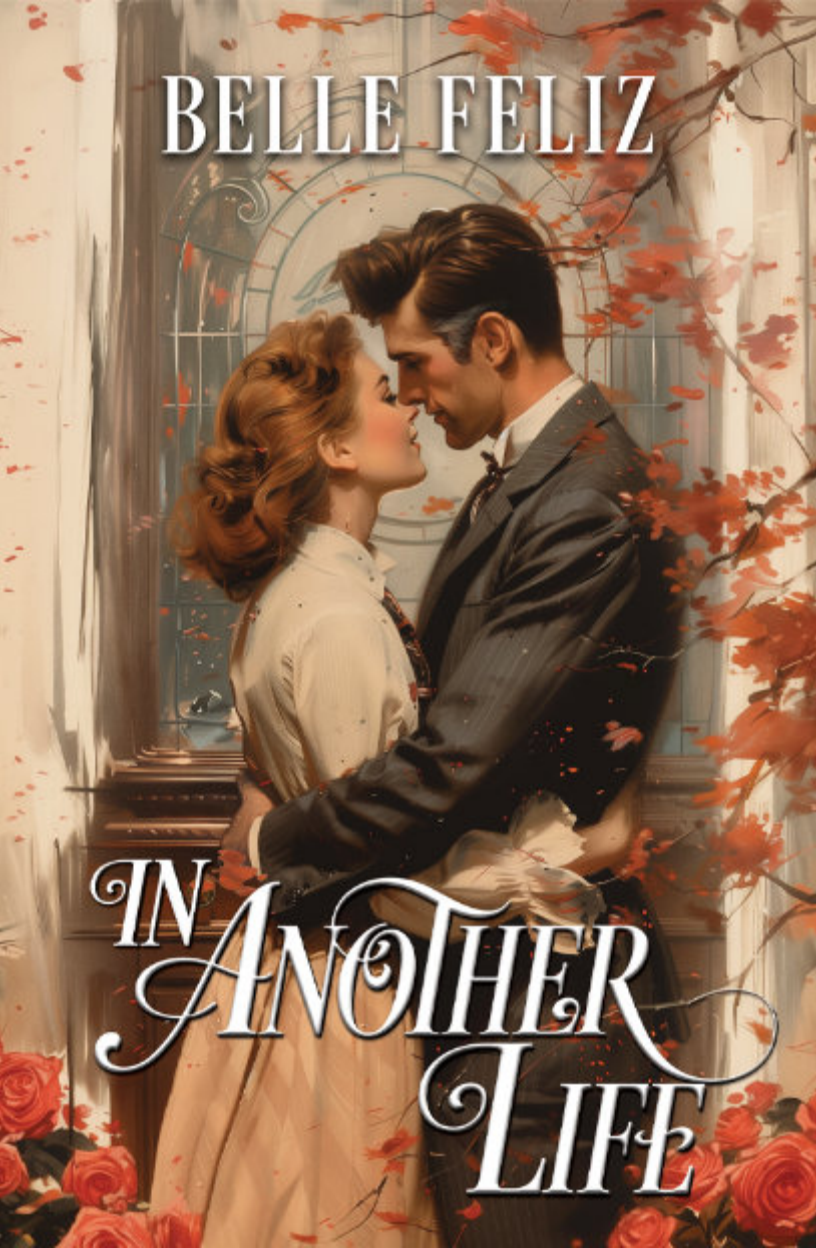




BELLE FELIZ
